
PRECAUTIONARY ARRANGEMENTS FOR TYPHOONS AND TROPICAL CYCLONES

Dear Member,

Members with vessels berthed at the Club are reminded to take all necessary measures to secure their vessels and maintain appropriate insurance coverage.

The Club's property insurance applies only to Club-owned assets. Its liability insurance does not cover members' assets, including vessels, equipment, or personal gear. Members are therefore encouraged to review their own insurance policies to ensure sufficient protection against damage caused by storms, typhoons, and other severe weather conditions. The Club shall not be responsible for any damage to members' assets, including damage resulting from the failure of Club equipment or any other cause.

To help safeguard vessels and maintain safety, members should observe the following precautions:

1. Inspect berthing lines, tie-downs, and related equipment to ensure they are in good condition and securely fastened.
2. Remove loose items from the deck, including sails, covers, and gear, and store them safely below deck.
3. Confirm that batteries are fully charged and all bilge pumps are functioning properly.
4. Monitor local weather forecasts and follow any further instructions issued by the relevant authorities.

Members' cooperation is appreciated. These measures help protect individual vessels, Club facilities, and the safety of all concerned.

Signal No. 1

Marina Facilities and Restaurant Services will operate as usual.

Signal No. 3

Marina Facilities

Members are required to return their yachts to their regular berthing pontoons.

Fuel Station will be opened as usual while Signal No. 3 is in force.

Restaurant Service will continue as usual while Signal No. 3 is in force.

Signal No. 8

Marine Facilities / Wave Breaker

When Tropical Cyclone Warning **Signal No. 1** is hoisted, all vessels berthed on the outer or inner side of the Club's wave breaker must remain on standby and be prepared to clear the wave breaker if **Signal No. 3** or above is hoisted.

Marina Facilities and Restaurant Services will cease **two hours before Signal No. 8** is hoisted and will resume no later than **two hours after Signal No. 8** is lowered.

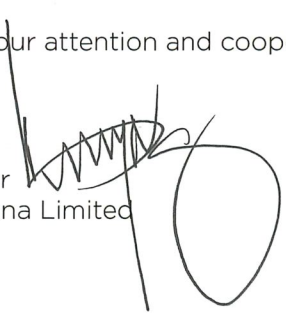
Fuel Station will be closed while Signal No. 8 is in force.

Signal No. 9 or No. 10

All Marina facilities and restaurant services will be closed while Signal No. 9 or Signal No. 10 is in force.
